

INFORMATION for the processing of personal data

United World Week 2025

pursuant to and for the purposes of art. 13 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679

We wish to inform you that your personal data will be used in compliance with the fundamental principles, dictated by Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003 Code regarding the protection of personal data and by European Regulation 679/2016 (hereinafter 'GDPR', or General Data Protection Regulation), implemented in Italy with Legislative Decree no. 101/2018.

1. Data Controllers

2. Personal data processing operations and related purposes

We summarize below all the operations we carry out that involve the collection, storage

or processing of your personal data and the purposes we pursue with each of them:

- management of the personal data of the people who participate in the activities organized and/or managed by New Humanity, but not limited to: training, events, seminars;
- storage of images on media intended for dissemination and used for promotional and/or journalistic purposes, in relation to events organized by New Humanity also in collaboration with other subjects, provided that they are filmed or recorded during participation in activities and/or events.

3. Freedom to give consent and consequences of refusal

The provision of consent to the processing of personal data is necessary for the service requested and accepted by the interested party.

4. Legal basis of the processing

The processing and purposes indicated above are made legitimate by the consent of the data subject, with the exception of processing required by law for which consent is not required.

Consent to the processing of images and their dissemination is also required.

5. Processing methods

Your data are processed with the support of paper, computer and telematic means and are protected through adequate security measures suitable to guarantee their confidentiality and integrity.

In particular, New Humanity undertakes to adopt appropriate organizational, procedural and technical measures (firewalls, antivirus and other technologies) to protect your data against loss, theft, as well as unauthorized use, disclosure or modification.

6. Recipients

6.1 - The data provided may be made available to employees working within NEW HUMANITY. (contact persons, collaborators, employees, persons in charge of processing data within the scope of their duties).

6.2. - Your data may be communicated to subjects, bodies or authorities to whom the communication of data is mandatory by law.

7. Data retention

Personal data will be stored until the cessation of activity and in compliance with legal obligations. Personal data whose retention is not necessary in relation to the purposes indicated will be deleted or transformed into anonymous form.

8. Rights of the data subject

The Applicable Legislation grants data subjects a series of rights including, but not limited to, the right:

- to access your Personal Data
- to request that it be rectified
- updating and deletion, if incomplete, incorrect or collected in violation of the law
- to request that the processing be limited to a part of the information concerning them
 - to transmit information concerning you to them or to third parties indicated by them (so-called "data portability")
- to object to their processing for legitimate reasons
- to revoke his/her consent at any time by means of an informal written request addressed to the Data Controller at the contacts indicated.

9. Provision of feedback to data subject requests and contact details

New Humanity also acts as data processor, also for the purpose of providing feedback to the data subject for the exercise of the rights referred to in Regulation (EU) 2016/679 ("GDPR").

It is therefore possible to contact New Humanity for any request, clarification or feedback on the application of the legislation on the protection of personal data and for the concrete exercise of the rights of the data subject, better indicated in the previous paragraph, even in the event that it is necessary to update, modify, integrate, correct and/or delete the data, as required by the law or in relation to the assessment of the specific needs explicitly envisaged by the data subject.
